- What

- Controlled vocabulary of licences regulating the use of Clarin language resources

- Why

- A clear specification of how and by whom a resource may be used, constitute crucial information which should be given for all Clarin resources. Using a controlled vocabulary for this makes it easier for end users to compare and select resources

- How

- Modelling the vocabulary in SKOS may be challenging
- Scope

Vocabulary of agents

- What
 - Controlled vocabulary of agents referenced in CLARIN metadata
- Why
 - All CLARIN resources must be connected to some agent, and most resources refer to several agents, each with their separate roles: Contact, creator, owner, funder, participant, etc. To ensure good quality of CMDI data, it is vital to reference agents in a consistent manner.
- How
 - Recap existing work:
 - Organization registry in CLAVAS (?)
 - Harmonize with international registries like viaf.org, isni.org, etc
- Who
 - CMDI TF + Curation TF? Or a separate Vocabulary TF?
- Issues
 - Modelling the vocabulary in SKOS may be challenging
 - Scope - what kind of agents? Both institutions, persons and projects?
