CLARIN?




- Common Language Resources and Technology
 Infrastructure
- aims at providing easy and sustainable access for scholars in the humanities and social sciences
 - to digital language data (in written, spoken, video or multimodal form)
 - to advanced tools to discover, explore, exploit, annotate, analyse or combine them

CLARIN centres



- A distributed architecture: (http-accessible) files, web applications and web services spread all over Europe
- Some of them password-protected (licenses, privacy, ...)
- User base: also spread over Europe


services to researcher




Federated Identity



- All centres that have password-protected resources are required to make them available via SAML
- Authorisation responsibility remains at centre





Current state



- CLARIN's Service Provider Federation (SPF)
 - 12 SPs (number is growing)
 - about 200 IdPs (from 7 countries)
- CLARIN ERIC is responsible legal entity
- further extension of the SPF
 - Connect more CLARIN services to it
 - Connect to more national identity federations

And eduGAIN?



- Initial plan (2008-2011)
- Pro:
 - you only need to join your national Identity Federation
 - no need for SPF (less administration)
 - access to non-EU user base
- But:
 - We need 100% IdP coverage per country
 - We cannot negotiate with 1000 IdPs individually
 - We need a fully working solution. Today.

And eduGAIN?



- Our hope:
 - opt-in policy will become opt-out policy
- In the meanwhile:
 - we support the eduGAIN Code of Conduct (it is a centre requirement) – investment in the future
 - use eduGAIN metadata distribution?
